RE: Butterfly Conservation

Back in November, our school made a pledge to create wild spaces to help improve the state of butterflies and moths in the UK. We have since been made aware of the Butterfly Recording Survey which records the numbers of butterflies and moths seen across Britain.

If you are interested in trying to help Butterfly Conservation, it would be great if you could record the butterflies that you see and log it on the survey. It is really easy and wouldn't take long to do -3 simple steps.

Step 1:

Sign up and register your garden at https://gardenbutterflysurvey.org/.

Step 2:

Submit sightings

Add your butterfly records. You can survey your garden all year round, as often as you like.



Step 3:

Survey reports

You can see your own results and find the latest reports from gardens across the UK.

Why it matters

Butterflies are some of our most beautiful garden visitors and they also have important roles to play in plant pollination and the food chain.

Butterflies are highly sensitive indicators of the health of the environment and we know many species are declining rapidly.
